A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND CHAPTER 168 OF THE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF CROTON-ON-HUDSON REGARDING ENFORCEMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION AREAS VIOLATIONS

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Croton-on-Hudson as follows:

Section One. Chapter 168, Parks and Recreation Areas, of the Code of the Village of Croton-on-Hudson, §168-10 is hereby amended to read as follows:

§168-10 Penalties for offenses; enforcement.

- A. A violation of any provision of this chapter shall constitute an offense punishable by a fine not to exceed \$250 for each and every such offense.
- B. Any Park Ranger in the employ of or under contract to the Village of Croton-on-Hudson observing a violation of this chapter in his presence is hereby authorized to issue and serve an appearance ticket for such violation.

Section Two. Severability

If any section, subsection, clause, phrase or other portion of this Local Law is, for any reason, declared invalid, in whole or in part, by any court, agency, commission, legislative body or other authority of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent portion. Such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof, which other portions shall continue in full force and effect.

Section Three. Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
