RE: Approval request for Urban SDK Agreement

Background:

The Police Department has allocated funds in the upcoming fiscal year budget for the purchase of Urban SDK software to assist with addressing traffic complaints, traffic safety concerns, and targeted enforcement efforts. The software will provide accurate real-time and historical data regarding traffic volume, vehicle speeds, and common crash locations.

This technology will allow the department to more efficiently address traffic-related complaints, identify problem areas throughout the city, and better utilize available resources for targeted traffic safety initiatives. Additionally, it will enhance our ability to proactively address concerns raised by residents and businesses.

Discussion:

Urban SDK will offer a discounted annual rate (\$3000 discount) if the agreement is signed prior to July 1, 2026. Urban SDK has also agreed that the City will not be invoiced until after July 1, 2026. Additionally, executing the agreement prior to July 1 will allow sufficient time for implementation and training so the department is prepared to fully utilize the software on or shortly after July 1.

Staff recommends approval to sign the agreement prior to July 1, 2026, with the understanding that the City will not be invoiced until after that date.
