We recruit, carefully screen and train caring adults to act as mentors, match them with children, and support the relationships on an ongoing basis. Research shows that our mentoring works. Kids with a Big Brother or Big Sister show real differences in their personal and academic lives. They are:

- More confident in their schoolwork performance.
- Able to get along better with their families.
- 52% less likely to skip school.
