Police Cadet Program

Croton Police Department will be starting a Police Cadet program in the fall of 2011. The program will be run by members of the Croton Police Department and will be geared toward men and women, ages 13-18 who have an interest in Law Enforcement.

Cadets in this program will be exposed to all aspects of law enforcement by providing them basic training and help them gain an appreciation for the police function in the community. Cadets will meet every other Tuesday for approximately two hours. During this time various topics will be instructed such as First Aid, radio communication, report writing, criminal law, courts, calls for service and careers in law enforcement as well as others. When Cadets finish the required training, they may be eligible for department ride along program where they ride with on patrol with a Croton Police Officer.

As Police Cadets, young adults may have the opportunity to assist the Croton Police Department with community events such as parades, fairs and other events. Cadets will also be exposed to units and services within the department such as SWAT, dive team, DARE program, car seat program and the bike unit. They will additionally be exposed to other units/departments within Westchester County and this will be done as field trips to sometimes replace bi-weekly meetings. Examples of these will include local courts, County Jail, K-9 units, aviation and local Fire Departments.

Cadets will have the chance to hear guest speakers from the District Attorney's office, DEA, FBI, local judges, Secret Service and other agencies to talk about roles they play in their department.

The Croton Police Cadet program will be affiliated with NERLEEA (Northeast Regional Law Enforcement Educational Association Inc). NERLEEA is a 501(c) 3 non-profit organization established in 2004. Their purpose is to network as many Law Enforcement youth programs together throughout the northeast region of the United States and to provide training, competitions and social events to the youth. Their goal is to develop these young men and woman into future leaders. The cost of membership with NERLEEA is \$65.00 per year for each unit plus \$4.00 per person (copies of applications attached). For each person registered with NERLEEA, they extend their group Accident Medical coverage they have through Nationwide insurance which covers up to \$25,000.00 in medical expenses as a primary policy while the cadets are participating in approved supervised programs.

NERLEEA Agreement

NERLEEA is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization incorporated in the state of CT as the Northeast Regional Law Enforcement Educational Association, Inc. Our function is to plan and conducts training classes, competitions and social events for law enforcement youth programs registered with us. Law enforcement youth programs include cadets, educational institutions with a Criminal Justice program and other youth programs registered with a local, state or federal law enforcement agency. Youth that can participate in our training programs must be no younger than 13 years of age and not exceed 20 years of age at the time of registration or renewal of membership. Youth younger than 13 years of age may only come to **observe only** unless otherwise specified. Students enrolled in a college criminal justice program over the age of 21 may come and take part in any classroom, however when it comes to hands on activities they can only participate as a role-player or observers, they will not be able to take part in the actual "officers" role unless prior approval has been arranged. All youth members of the association shall be called cadets. Members of the association are covered by our excess accident insurance policy for all approved activities with NERLEEA and your own agency. For information concerning insurance please direct them to the NERLEEA Board of Directors. By registering as a member of the association you understand that we are not associated with the Boy Scouts of America, Learning for Life or Law Enforcement Exploring, all of which are trademarked by the Boy Scouts of America. It is the policy of the NERLEEA that all groups that attend our events as participants must be registered as a member with the association with a signed application on file. In addition to this each individual youth member and advisor must be registered with an application on file and registration fees paid. Your membership must be renewed annually (January of each year). You also agree to register and pay for new members through the year so they may be added to our insurance policy. By signing this agreement you acknowledge and agree to all of the conditions outlined in this document.
