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FURTHER COMMANDED to receive and collect such sums without additional charge until July 1, 2022, and thereafter to collect such of the sums as have not been theretofore collected, an additional charge of five per centum for the first month or fraction thereof and one percent for each month or fraction thereof thereafter until paid.

YOU ARE FURTHER COMMANDED, to return the tax roll and warrant to the Village Clerk on or before the first day of February, 2023, and to deliver to the Board of Trustees at the same time an account of the taxes remaining unpaid: describing each parcel of real property upon which taxes are unpaid, showing the person or persons to whom the parcel is assessed and showing as to each parcel the amount of tax unpaid.
