The Annual Election in the Village of Croton on Hudson, NY, was held on Tuesday, March 18, 1980. The polls were opened at 6:00 a.m. and closed at 9:00 p.m.; voting was conducted at the following polling places:

- #3 - Grand St. Firehouse, 152 Grand St.
- #4 - Our Saviour Lutheran Church, Cleveland Dr.
- #5 - Harmon Engine Firehouse, Benedict Blvd.
- #6 - CET School, Gerstein St.

The Clerk produced the returns of the Inspectors of Election and read them aloud-said returns were as follows:

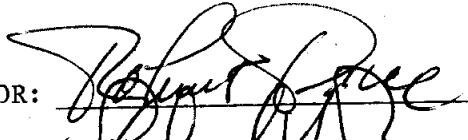
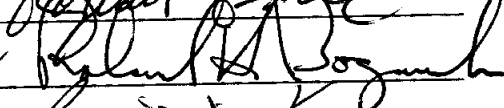
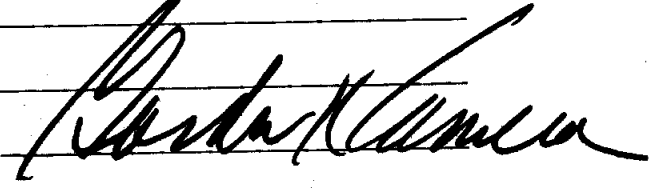
