See below, as well as the attached file, for the Bond Act allocations (total \$4.2 billion):

- \$1.1 billion for flood risk reduction (increase of \$100 million from original)
 - \$250 million for property buyout
 - \$100 million shoreline protection
 - \$100 million waterfront revitalization
- \$650 million for open space and land conservation (increase of \$100 million)
 - \$75 million for fish hatcheries
 - \$300 million for open space
 - \$150 million farmland protection
- \$1.5 billion for climate change mitigation (increase of \$800 million)
 - \$500 million for electric school buses and chargers
 - \$400 million for green buildings (enacted agreement adds school districts as eligible recipients)
 - \$100 million for climate change adaptation and mitigation
 - \$200 million to address air and water pollution in disadvantaged communities
- \$650 million for water quality improvement (increase of \$100 million)
 - \$200 million for water infrastructure improvement
 - \$250 million for municipal stormwater grants
- \$300 million unallocated (increase of \$100 million)

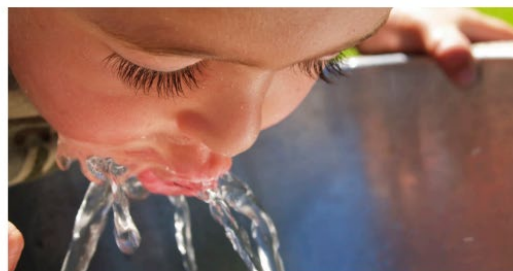
The Bond Act passed in the SFY 20-21 Budget, as well as the SFY 22-23 Budget. The Budget bills are:

- 2022: S.8004D (SFY 22-23 Budget Capital bill)
- 2022: S.8008C (SFY 22-23 TEDE Art VII)

SAFEGUARD DRINKING WATER

New York's rivers and lakes supply drinking water to millions of New Yorkers every day. The Bond Act will invest at least \$650 million to protect clean drinking water by replacing lead pipes, expanding sewers, updating water treatment plants, and preventing pollution and runoff.



PRESERVE FARMS AND FORESTS

From Ellis Island to the Adirondack Mountains, New York is defined by its unique, natural scenery. Parks, forests, and farms provide mental and physical health benefits. The Bond Act will invest at least \$650 million to conserve open space, protect family farms, and expand access to parks, campgrounds, and nature centers.

STRENGTHEN NEW YORK'S ECONOMY

Replacing lead pipes, updating sewers, fixing roads, and retrofitting buildings – all create jobs. The Bond Act will help revitalize local cities, towns, and villages by supporting nearly 100,000 good, local, family-sustaining jobs.



ADVANCE ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE

Every New Yorker deserves clean air to breathe, clean water to drink, and access to nature. But not everyone does. The Bond Act will help advance environmental justice by directing at least 35-40 percent of total funding to disadvantaged communities, those most harmed by pollution.

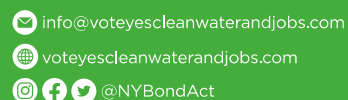

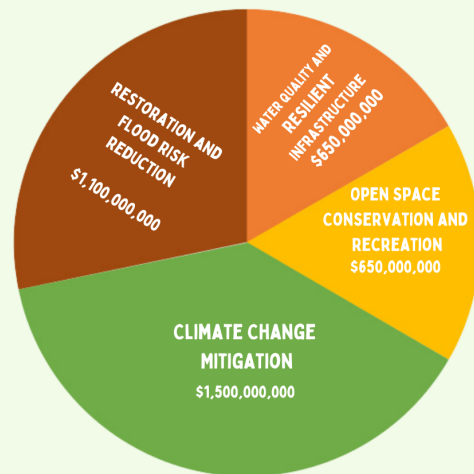
