

PUBLIC WORKS QUARTERLY REPORT

Fiscal Year 2024/2025

First Quarter: June 1, 2024 – August 31, 2024

Highway

- Cleaned sanitary sewer lines
- Swept 140 miles of roadway
- Started the yard waste removal program throughout the Village
- Installed Veterans banners throughout the Village
- Removed and replaced banners for various Village events
- Installed summer banners and American flags throughout Village
- Repaired 7 catch basins
- Cleaned out 64 catch basins
- Weekly asphalt maintenance (potholes and water patches)
- Trimmed approximately 40 trees
- Removed 12 trees (including grinding leftover stumps)
- Planted 3 trees
- Train Station parking lot plantings
- Installed 2 new kayak racks at Echo Canoe Launch

Sanitation:

- Collected approximately 743 tons of refuse
- Weekly collection of Village co-mingled, paper and metal recycling
- Collected approximately 199 tons of organic waste

Building Maintenance:

- Refinished VCT floors at Grand Street and Harmon Firehouses.
- Refurbished street lights on North Riverside Avenue.
- Installed speed sign on Maple Street.
- Installed cameras at Black Rock Park.
- Replaced various signage throughout Village.

Water Department:

- Meter reading for water billing
- Painted hydrants
- Maintenance to pumps and motors
- Plumbing work at Senasqua Bathhouse, EMS house, and Croton Landing
- Westchester County Health Department inspection
- Semi-annual lead and copper samples
- Responded to 127 code 53-mark outs
- Submission of monthly reports to Westchester County
- Completed Mage Meter installation at Well Field
- Mag Meter / Flow meter calibrations
- Worked with contractor on 41-51 Maple Street for existing and proposed water connections
- Assist DPW on low staff days

- Completed monthly water sampling

Parks Department:

- Continued mowing of lawns/field in all Village parks
- Litter removal in Village parks and fields
- Assistance with Village entertainment programs at Senasqua
- Assistance with the planning of Oktoberfest
- Assisted with Village Arts Festival at Senasqua

Repair Facility:

- Preparing all necessary vehicles and equipment for the upcoming leaf season
- Weekly inspection and maintenance of all police vehicles
- Assist Fire Department with vehicle maintenance
- Auctioned 2 DPW vehicles for surplus. Funds to be used for replacement and equipment

Capital Projects:

- Continue discussions with contractor for Train Station Parking Lot solar project
- Continued the in-house renovation of the Police Department
- Completed new parking lot on Wayne Street
- Moved utilities (drainage, electric, gas) at Harmon Firehouse addition (new EMS) to accommodate new foundation for building
- Scheduled delivery of granite curbing at Gotwald Circle
- Continue design of Brook Street drainage with design Engineer
