

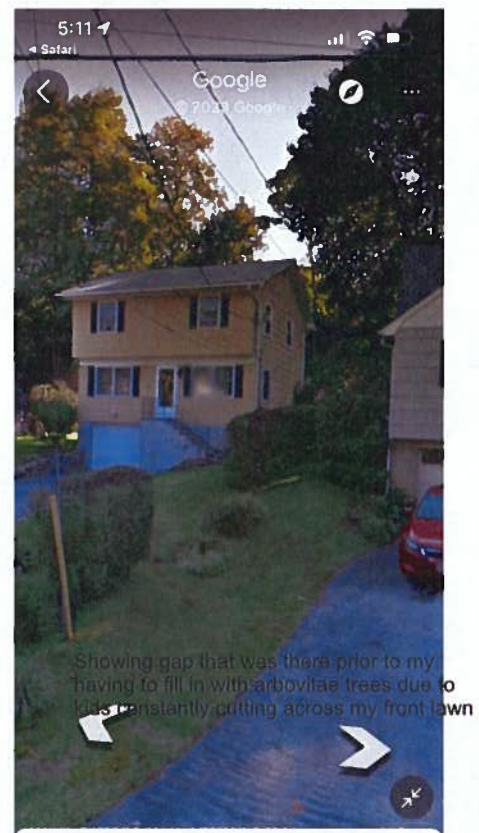
36 Wells Ave-Fence



This shows measurement from property corner stake. Fence starts 9.5 feet from edge of street. 3.5' from stake. 2nd post is at 12' from stake 15.5' from street. to accommodate the 15' I am requesting variance for would mean taking down 1 complete panel & a 3' portion of 2nd panel (Panels are 8' wide)
If I cannot get complete variance (which I sincerely hope I will), I would ask that I can at least only take the panel down, otherwise would require moving post and cutting down 2nd panel incurring extra cost.

* I think replacing, what would be 11.5' of fence with a 4' fence, would not be aesthetically pleasing and will not prevent cutting of my trees
