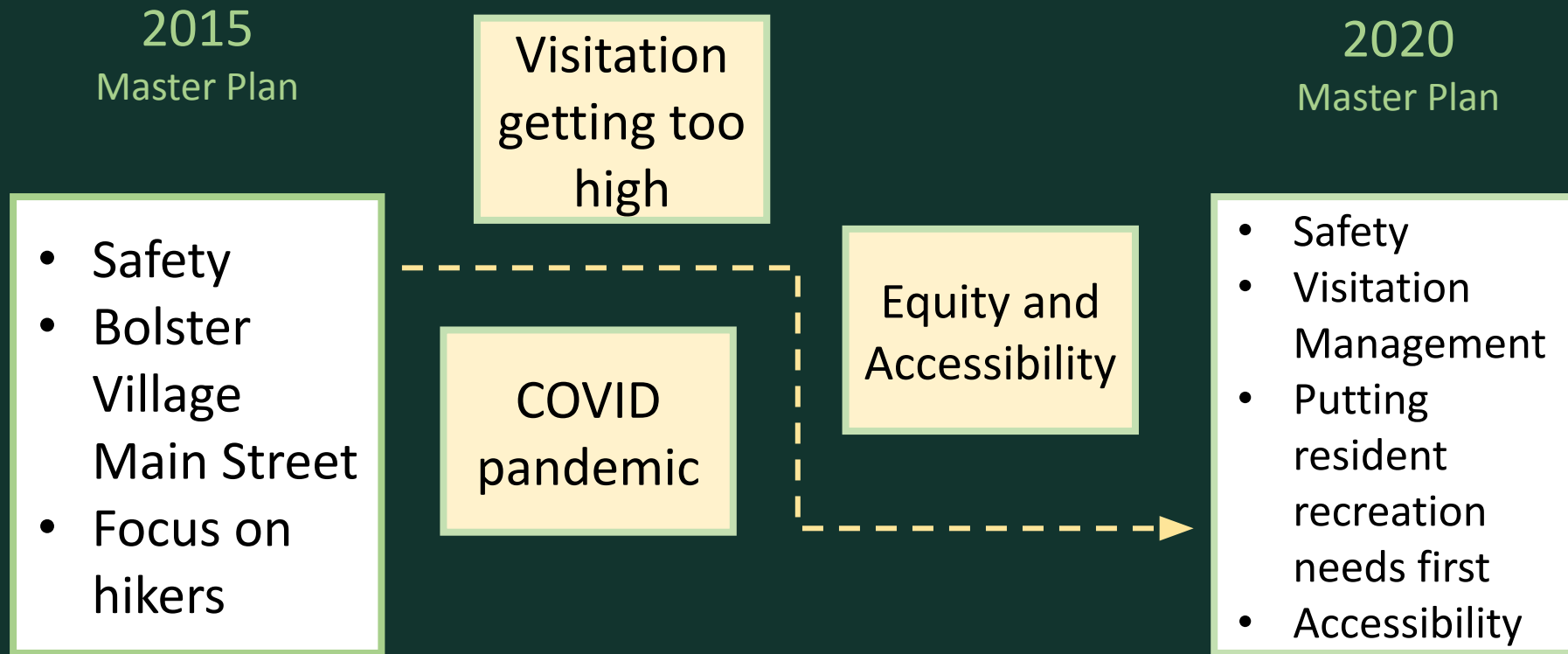

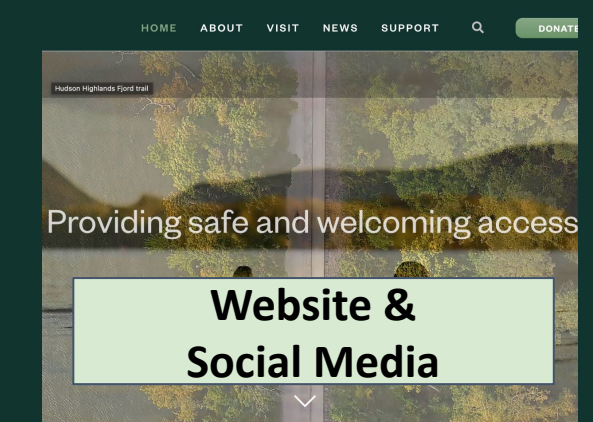

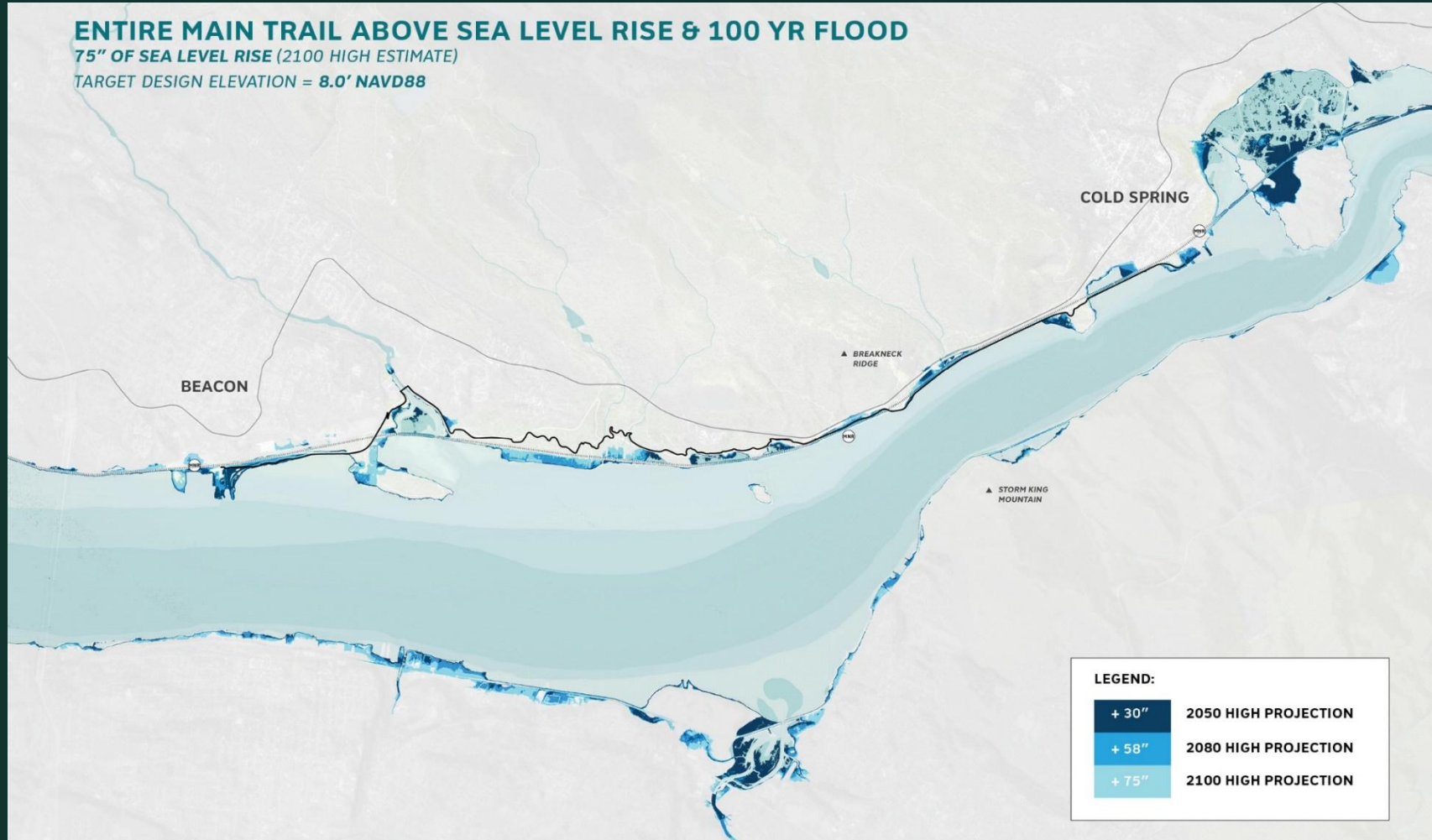
The Vision: A Trail for All

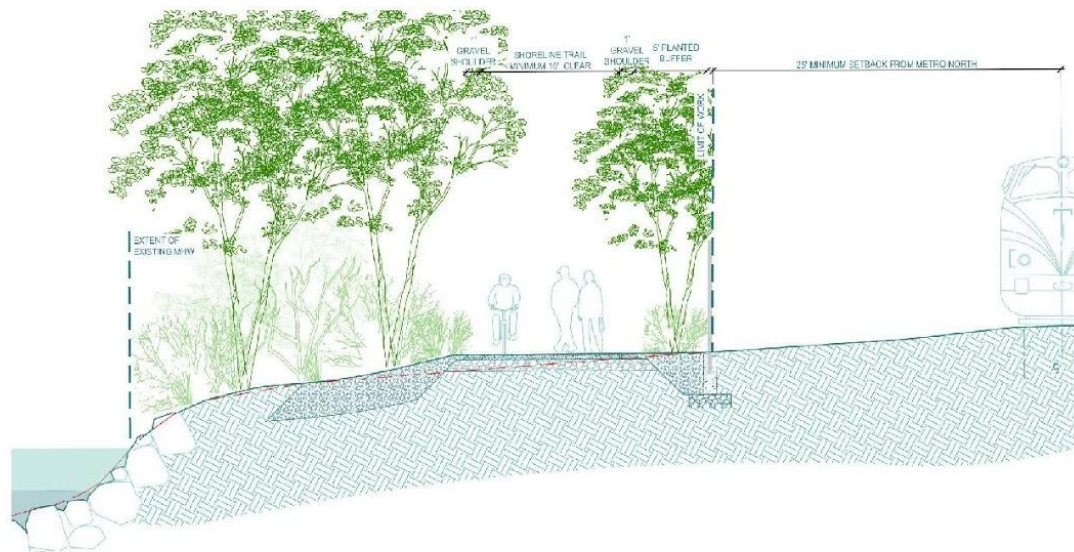
CONCEPT DESIGN ALIGNMENT



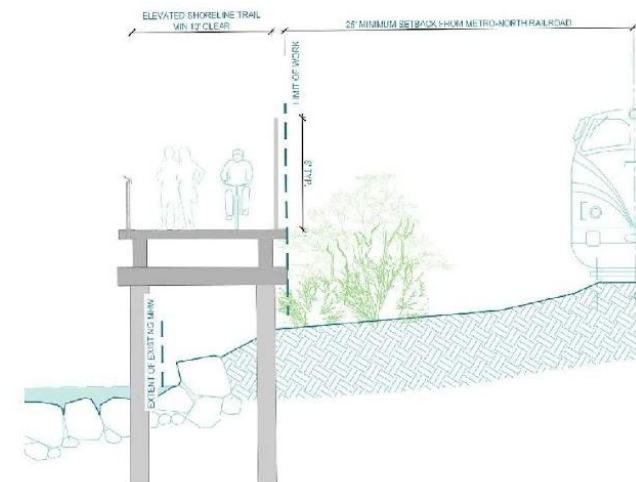

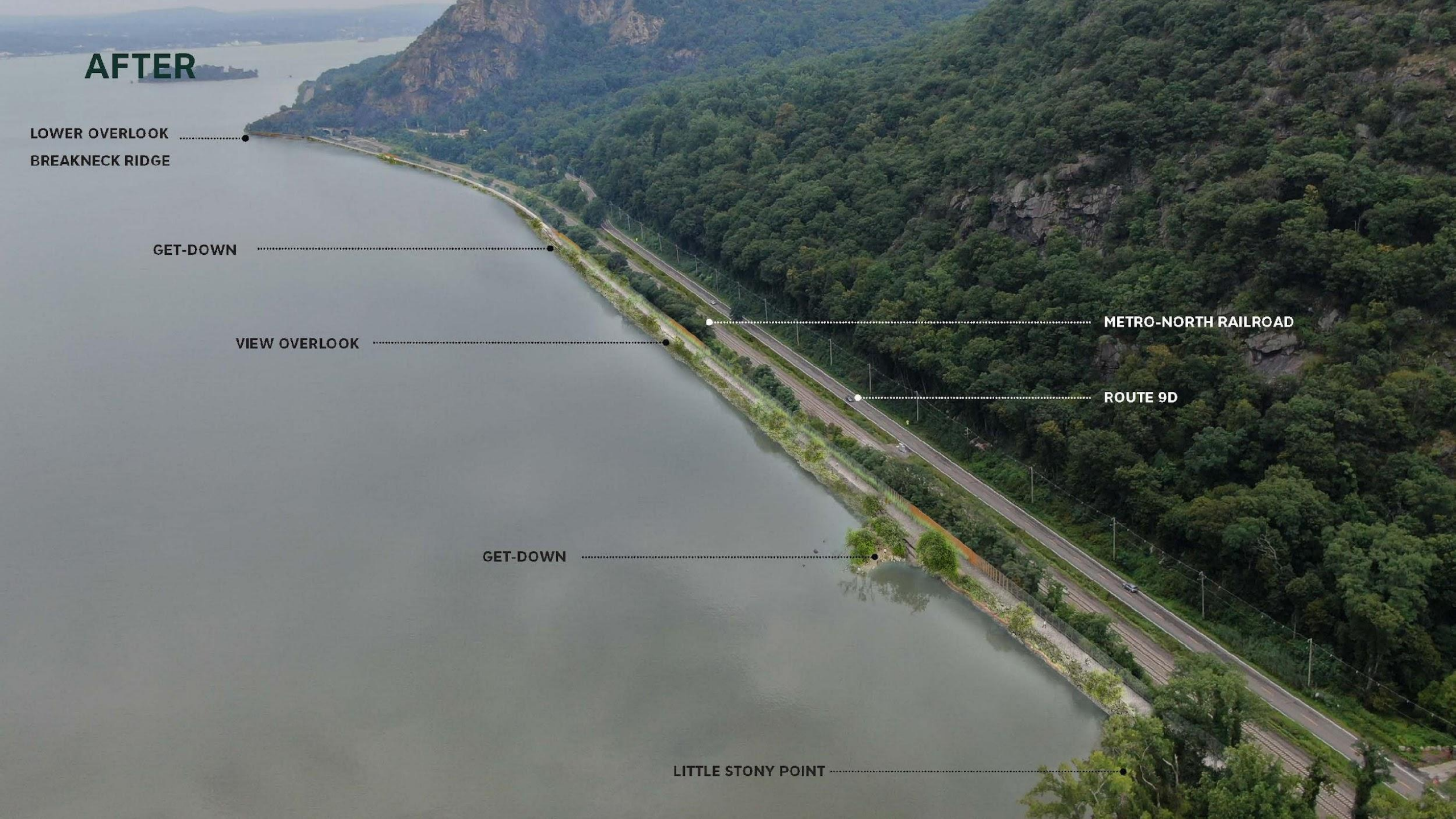

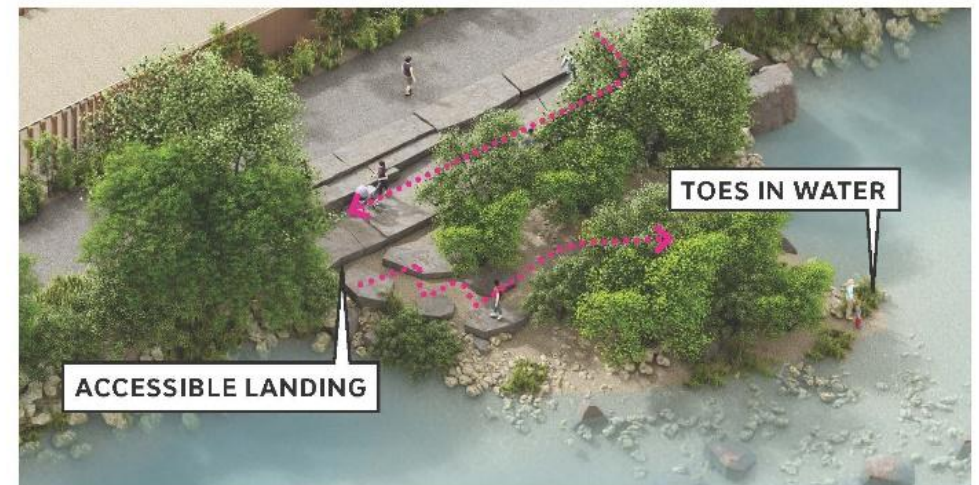
