WHEREAS, the Village Board is further committed to supporting the visibility, dignity, and equality for all people in the community; and

WHEREAS, LGBTQ+ Pride month is commemorated in June to honor the 1969 Stonewall Uprising, which is considered where the movement for LGBTQ+ rights began; and

WHEREAS, cities, towns, and villages across the United States recognize and celebrate June as LGBTQ+ Pride month; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Croton-on-Hudson Board of Trustees wishes to communicate its support for inclusivity, equality, and respect in the Village, denounces homophobia and transphobia, and desires to recognize and celebrate June as LGBTQ+ Pride month,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Croton-on-Hudson hereby declares the month of June 2025 as LGBTQ+ Pride month in the Village of Croton-on-Hudson.
