Dear Resident:

As you may be aware, the Village of Croton-on-Hudson enacted a residential parking permit system along portions of Hastings Avenue and Young Avenue in 2021, after the governor signed home rule legislation that allowed the Village to institute such a system. The system exists today on Hastings Avenue, between Benedict Blvd. and Devon Avenue, and Young Avenue, between Oneida Avenue and Benedict Blvd.

At that time, residents on the other blocks of Hastings and Young Avenue chose not to have such a system, and retained the status quo of time limit restrictions (on Young Avenue between Benedict Blvd, and Devon Avenue), or no restrictions at all.

However, the driving and commuting habits of people have changed along these streets as people return to their offices. Some residents have contacted the Village Board in recent months asking that the residential parking permit system be expanded. The Board of Trustees has requested another survey be taken to see if support exists for such changes. A survey is located on the reverse of this letter to gauge support in your neighborhood.

**As required by Article X, Chapter 215 of the Village Code, the residential parking permit would be in effect between 7 A.M. to 7 P.M., Monday through Friday. There would be no restrictions on weekend days. Non-residents are permitted to park up to 4 hours during the days and hours listed above; residents with a parking permit would not be time-limited.**

Each household would qualify for two free permits, with subsequent permits costing \$10 each.
