 WHEREAS, on July 1, 2021, the Property Appraiser of Lee County, Florida served upon the Village of Estero a "Certification of Taxable Value" certifying to the Village of Estero its taxable value; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statute Section 200.065, requires that within thirty-five (35) days of service of the Certification of Taxable Value upon a municipality, said municipality shall furnish to the Property Appraiser the proposed millage rate, the rolled-back rate, and the date, time and place at which a public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and the budget for Fiscal Year 2021-2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Village Council of the Village of Estero, Florida:

 Section 1. The proposed millage rate for fiscal year 2021-2022 to be discussed at the first budget hearing is hereby declared to be 0.7726 mills (\$0.7726 per \$1,000 of assessed property value). This proposed operating millage rate is greater than the rolled-back rate of 0.7486 mills by 3.21%.

Section 2. The Village Council hereby sets the date, time and place for the budget hearings required by Florida Statutes as follows:
