Agenda Item:

U.S. Bike Route 15

Description:

The U.S. Bicycle Route System (USBRS) is a developing national network of bicycle routes intended to facilitate travel and provide connectivity between communities. The USBRS includes approximately 14,000 miles of bicycle routes in 31 states. The intent is to encompass over 50,000 miles when complete. The USBRS has been approved by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and the American Association of State Highway Transportation Officials (AASHTO). Adventure Cycling Association is the technical support organization to AASHTO that is identifying proposed routes for the USBRS.

Adventure Cycling is currently proposing to extend U.S. Bike Route 15 from Madison, Florida to Miami, Florida. This will add 496 miles to the existing route. This alignment runs through Lee County, City of Fort Myers, Village of Estero, and City of Bonita Springs. The proposed alignment includes the following:

- Daniels Parkway from Metro Parkway to Treeline Ave.
- Treeline Ave./Ben Hill Griffin Parkway from Daniels Parkway to Estero Parkway
- Estero Parkway from Ben Hill Griffin Parkway to Three Oaks Parkway
- Three Oaks Parkway/Imperial Parkway/Livingston Rd from Estero Parkway to Golden Gate Parkway.

The sections along Estero Parkway and Three Oaks Parkway are both located within the Village of Estero on roadways owned and operated by Lee County.

The proposed alignment received input from the Lee County MPO Bicycle Pedestrian Coordinating Committee (BPCC). The committee supports the proposed alignment.

The proposed USBR 15 through Estero will provide a benefit to Village residents and businesses with no costs to the Village.





U.S. Bike Route 15 in Georgia






Florida Bike Routes









Proposed & Existing U.S. Bike Routes in Florida




