
Zoning & Planning Options for Estero on the River





Designate property south of the river for public use

(including Happehatchee property)





Majority of property is zoned "Mixed Use"

Under Lee County Zoning Resolution Z-07-021





Mixed Use allows:

- * Residential Single & Multi-Family Units
- * Commercial Uses
- * Mixed Use Parcels
- * Civic uses
- * Preserve and Indigenous Areas

Happehatchee property is zoned "Agriculture"





Development pressure is INTENSE in Estero

How can we protect our investment?





A more appropriate zoning designation is: "Parks & Community Facilities"

- * This zoning category is specific for publicly owned property
- * Allows active & passive recreation, preserved lands and civic uses





How do we do this? Village-Initiated Rezoning





Village-Initiated Rezoning Steps

- 1. Village owns property
- 2. Village Council votes to begin rezoning process
- 3. Staff prepares application
- 4. Public Information Meeting held at Planning, Zoning & Design Board
- 5. Staff prepares staff report & recommendation
- 6. Public Hearing at Planning, Zoning and Design Board (PZDB makes recommendation to Council)
- 7. Village Council reviews in two advertised public hearings
- 8. If approved, zoning map is changed





Tentative Schedule

- Mar 16 Council Workshop
 April 20 Vote to initiate rezoning
 May 10 Public Info. Meeting at PZDB
 June 14 Public Hearing at PZDB
 July 6 1st Council Meeting
- July 20 2nd Council Meeting

Expected Timeframe: 4 Months





For additional protection Comprehensive Plan Category may also be changed





Comprehensive Plan Category

- Comprehensive Plan category is "Village Center"
- Village Center allows parks
- Category can be changed later to "Public Parks & Recreation"
- This process is more time consuming because it involves State Review and specific advertising requirements & timeframes





Comp. Plan Amendment Schedule

- **Council votes to "initiate" amendment** April May Staff review & PIM at PZDB June **PZDB** Public Hearing **Council votes to transmit to State**
- July
- Aug State review
- **Council adopts at 2nd Public Hearing** Sept/Oct

Tentative timeframe: 6 months
