RESOLUTION NO. 2026 –17

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ESTERO, FLORIDA, DETERMINING THE PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027, SETTING THE DATE, TIME AND PLACE FOR THE PUBLIC HEARINGS REQUIRED BY STATE LAW; DIRECTING STAFF TO TRANSMIT NECESSARY DOCUMENTATION PURSUANT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF FLORIDA STATUTES AND THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2026, the Property Appraiser of Lee County, Florida served upon the Village of Estero a “Certification of Taxable Value” certifying to the Village of Estero its taxable value; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statute Section 200.065, requires that within thirty-five (35) days of service of the Certification of Taxable Value upon a municipality, said municipality shall furnish to the Property Appraiser the proposed millage rate, the rolled-back rate, and the date, time and place at which a public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and the budget for Fiscal Year 2026-2027.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ESTERO, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The proposed millage rate for fiscal year 2026-2027 to be discussed at the first budget hearing is hereby declared to be 0.7300 mills (\$0.7300 per \$1,000 of assessed property value). This proposed operating millage rate is less than the rolled-back rate of 0.7336 mills by 0.49%.

Section 2. The Village Council hereby sets the date, time and place for the budget hearings required by Florida Statutes as follows:

Section 3. The Village Manager or designee is hereby directed to transmit all necessary documentation in compliance with the rules and regulations of the Florida Department of Revenue on their Internet-based system for completing and submitting documents for the Florida's Truth-In-Millage (TRIM) and maximum millage oversight process.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
