

RESOLUTION 2026-14

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF ESTERO, FLORIDA, APPROVING EXECUTION OF A TRANSPORTATION OFF SYSTEM POST PROJECT MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH FDOT FOR COCONUT ROAD IMPROVEMENTS; MAKING RELATED FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Florida Statutes § 339.08 and the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century (MAP-21) program, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is authorized to undertake a project within the Village of Estero (Village) geographical limits; and

WHEREAS, the said project is identified and known to the Parties as Financial Project #449683-1-52-01 (at Coconut Road) which will benefit the Village; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Title 23, U.S. Code, § 116 and Federal Highway Administration regulations issued pursuant thereto, there must be an agreement from the Village to maintain the project after it has been completed (Agreement); and

WHEREAS, the Agreement requires adoption of a Resolution accepting the obligations of the Agreement and authorizing its execution.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council of the Village of Estero, Florida, that:

Section 1. The Transportation Off System Post Project Maintenance Agreement between the FDOT and Village for Financial Project #449683-1-52-01 (attached hereto and incorporated herein) is hereby approved.

Section 2. The Mayor or Village Manager is authorized to execute the Agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, provision or word of this Resolution is held unconstitutional or otherwise legally invalid, same shall be severable and the remainder of this Resolution shall not be affected by such invalidity, such that any remainder of the Resolution shall withstand any severed provision, as the Village Council would have adopted the Resolution even absent the invalid part.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
