

RESOLUTION 58-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW, TENNESSEE, APPROVING THE SCHEMATIC DESIGN FOR HISTORICAL VILLAGE PARK AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO SEEK FUNDING BY APPLYING FOR THE 2026 LOCAL PARKS AND RECREATION FUND (LPRF) GRANT

WHEREAS, the City of Fairview has contracted with Kimley-Horn to provide Professional Design, Architectural, and Engineering Services for Historical Village Park; and

WHEREAS, the design and schematic plan outlines the proposed layout, amenities, structures, and features that align with the vision and goals of the city for this space; and

WHEREAS, the city desires to seek funding for Historical Village Park by applying for the Local Parks and Recreation Fund (LPRF) Grant administered by TDEC's Office of Outdoor Recreation which is a 50-50 match grant that is awarded to municipalities for the design and construction of park projects; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners acknowledges its responsibility to provide the required local match if the grant is awarded.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby formally accepts the schematic design for Historical Village Park as presented by Kimley-Horn.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes city staff to apply for the 2026 Local Parks and Recreation Fund (LPRF) Grant.

Section 3. The Board of Commissioners commits to providing the local match required by the grant, if awarded.

Section 4. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the City Manager and staff to execute all documents and take all actions necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.
