

**RESOLUTION 28-26**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW, TENNESSEE, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT IN FAVOR OF MIDDLE TENNESSEE ELECTRIC MEMBERSHIP CORPORATION**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fairview, Tennessee (“City”) has determined that it is necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of Fairview to grant a utility easement to Middle Tennessee Electric Membership Corporation (“MTE”) for the installation, construction, operation, maintenance, repair, replacement, and improvement of electric transmission and/or distribution lines and related facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, MTE has requested that the City execute a Right-of-Way Easement granting certain rights for electric utility infrastructure as described in the easement document attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners finds that granting said easement will promote and support reliable electric utility service within the City and surrounding areas; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners desires to authorize the Mayor to execute the necessary easement documents and any related documents required to complete this transaction.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby approves the granting of a Right-of-Way Easement to Middle Tennessee Electric Membership Corporation in substantially the same form as the easement document presented to the Board.

Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Right-of-Way Easement and any associated documents necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution on behalf of the City of Fairview.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
