Resolution No. 01

RESOLUTION (A) APPROVING CERTAIN REVISIONS TO VARIOUS POLICIES OF THE TOWN OF GUILDERLAND INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY (THE "AGENCY"); AND (B) APPROVING VARIOUS CHARTERS OF THE COMMITTEES OF THE AGENCY.

WHEREAS, Town of Guilderland Industrial Development Agency (the "Agency") is authorized and empowered by the provisions of Chapter 1030 of 1969 Laws of New York, constituting Title 1 of Article 18-A of the General Municipal Law, Chapter 24 of the Consolidated Laws of New York, as amended (the "Enabling Act") and Chapter 146 of the 1973 Laws of New York, as amended, constituting Section 909-a of said General Municipal Law (said Chapter and the Enabling Act being hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Act") to promote, develop, encourage and assist in the acquiring, constructing, reconstructing, improving, maintaining, equipping and furnishing of industrial, manufacturing, warehousing, commercial, research and recreation facilities, among others, for the purpose of promoting, attracting and developing economically sound commerce and industry to advance the job opportunities, health, general prosperity and economic welfare of the people of the State of New York, to improve their prosperity and standard of living, and to prevent unemployment and economic deterioration; and

WHEREAS, under Section 858 of the Act, the Agency has the power to approve certain administrative matters; and

WHEREAS, the Agency has adopted various policies regarding the operations of the Agency and the granting of assistance for projects undertaken in the Town of Guilderland, New York (the "Agency Policies"); and

WHEREAS, the staff of the Agency has reviewed the Agency Policies and has worked with Agency counsel to make recommendations to the members of the Agency regarding certain revisions to certain Agency Policies (collectively, the "Review"); and

WHEREAS, based on the Review, counsel to the Agency prepared comments and revisions (the "Proposed Revisions") to the following Agency Policies: (A) Discretionary Funds Policy; (B) Media Policy; (C) PAAA Policy; (D) Policy Respecting Recapture of Project Benefits; (E) Procurement Policy; and (F) Uniform Tax Exemption Policy. A copy of the Proposed Revisions has been presented to the members at the meeting and are on file at the office of the Agency; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of the Public Authorities Law of the State of New York (the "PAL"), the Agency has established various committees of the Agency including the: (1) Audit Committee, (2) Finance Committee, and (3) Governance Committee (collectively, the "Committees"); and

WHEREAS, further based on the Review, counsel to the Agency prepared charters of each of the Committees (the "Charters," and collectively with the Proposed Revisions, the "Proposed Administrative Materials"). Copies of the Charters have been presented to the members at the meeting and are on file at the office of the Agency; and

WHEREAS, members of the Agency and staff of the Agency have reviewed the Proposed Administrative Materials with counsel to the Agency; and

WHEREAS, as provided by the PAL, and in the proposed Charter of the Governance Committee of the Agency, the members of the Governance Committee have reviewed the Proposed Administrative Materials and made certain recommendations to the full board regarding approving the Proposed Administrative Materials; and

WHEREAS, final drafts of the Proposed Administrative Materials have been presented to the members of the Agency and the members of the Agency have reviewed the final drafts presented at this meeting; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Agency desire to approve the Proposed Administrative Materials;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE TOWN OF GUILDERLAND INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Agency hereby approves the Proposed Administrative Materials, presented and reviewed by the members of the Agency.

<u>Section 2</u>. The Agency hereby authorizes the Chair, Vice Chair, or Chief Executive Officer of the Agency to take all steps necessary to implement the Proposed Administrative Materials.
