# **COMPREHENSIVE PLAN PROCESS**

A Comprehensive Plan is both a vision for the future and a blueprint for how to get there. A Comprehensive Plan creates a framework for future decision-making on a range of topics such as land use, economic development, infrastructure, and housing. The Town of Guilderland adopted its current Comprehensive Plan in 2001, and the update process will help guide Guilderland into the future.



#### A Growing Guilderland

The Town is growing and it is important to balance growth with preservation of attributes that make it attractive to live. That balance includes varied housing types, location of growth, protection of natural resources and support for agricultural operations as well as a mix of commercial activity that will attract a range of age cohorts.

#### **Western Avenue**

Serving as the Town's de facto 'Main Street', there are opportunities for redevelopment and enhanced pedestrian facilities. Increased traffic and coordination with NYSDOT are important considerations.















#### **Community Character**

The is no single character that represents the Town, but rather a mix and diversity of character and development patterns that defines the community. Character ranges from rural western Guilderland to the more suburban-like residential neighborhoods to the more compact historic neighborhoods. Therefore, community character is addressed in several ways across multiple plan topic areas.

#### **Connections**

With a growing community as well as an aging community, there is a focus on connecting new and existing neighborhoods and other destinations through a trail network to enhance accessibility and alternatives to vehicle travel.

Agriculture

Ensure the long-term viability of agriculture as a vocation and economic pursuit within the Town of Guilderland by prioritizing the preservation of suitable farmland and by promoting agriculture as an important component of the Town's economy and character.

Business, Employment & Fiscal Resources

Establish and promote a diverse and strategic economic base that provides income, employment, and revenue to the community in a manner compatible with the future land use and unique identity of Guilderland.

Protect the natural resources that support quality of life and Town character in Guilderland through strategic hazard mitigation and resiliency measures to address the impacts of a changing climate.

Neighborhoods & Housing

Provide a balanced blend of quality housing opportunities, including a desirable range of housing types and price ranges, which are affordable and accessible to residents.

Parks, Recreation, Open Space & Historic Resources

- Provide access to a diverse network of well maintained active and passive recreational facilities for Guilderland residents of all ages and abilities.
- Prioritize the preservation of open space in the Town of Guilderland, particularly where such areas perform critical ecosystem functions and/or contribute to scenic resources that influence the character, aesthetics, economy, health and welfare of the Town.
- Preserve Guilderland's historic resources and enhance cultural opportunities in the community.

Transportation & Mobility

Provide safe, convenient, and efficient transportation options for people and goods within, through and around the Town of Guilderland, which are supportive of the Town's future land use plan and which minimize the negative impacts of traffic on the Town's character and quality of life.
