RESOLUTION TO REQUEST THE AUTHORITY TO LEVY IMPACT FEES IN TOWN OF NOLENSVILLE IN THE EVENT OF A CHARTER CHANGE

WHEREAS, the Town of Nolensville has the authority to assess fees for the use of or impact upon infrastructure pursuant to the authority of mayor-aldermanic charter cities as set forth in Sec. 6-2-201 (14) and (15), Tennessee Code Annotated; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Nolensville approved Ordinance #07-12, adopting a road impact fee on June 28, 2007; and

WHEREAS, updated impact fees were adopted in Ordinance #17-02 on July 1, 2017 based on the work of qualified transportation engineering and impact fee professionals using current and best available data and practices; and

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF NOLENSVILLE, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. that the Board of Mayor and Alderman request State Representative Glen Casada and State Senator Jack Johnson to take legislative action, including passage of a Private Act, to ensure and protect Nolensville's authority to levy Impact Fees in the event of a charter change, forthwith.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately, the public welfare requiring it.
