**RESOLUTION #26-041**

**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE DISCONTINUANCE OF THE HISTORIC DISTRICT STREETScape PROJECT FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN AND THE TDOT MULTI-MODAL ACCESS GRANT**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Nolensville has adopted a Capital Improvement Program (CIP) to identify, prioritize, and plan for major public infrastructure projects; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Historic District Streetscape Project was previously included among the Town of Nolensville's capital improvement priorities; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Historic District Streetscape Project is being implemented through a multi-modal access grant awarded to the Town of Nolensville by the Tennessee Department of Transportation; and

**WHEREAS**, upon further review, the Board of Commissioners have determined that project costs have increased substantially, rendering the Historic District Streetscape Project no longer financially feasible and making its discontinuance from inclusion in the Town of Nolensville's adopted Capital Improvement Plan and thus, the project being discontinued under the multi-modal access grant; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners intends to discontinue the TDOT multi-modal grant project and all remaining phases of the project including, but not limited to, right-of-way acquisition, utility relocation, and construction and related work.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF NOLENSVILLE, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the removal of the Historic District Streetscape Project from the Town of Nolensville Capital Improvement Plan as a priority transportation improvement project.

**SECTION 2.** The Board of Commissioners hereby discontinues the project and all remaining work effective upon finalizing all remaining project expense reimbursements between the Town of Nolensville and the Tennessee Department of Transportation.

**SECTION 3.** The removal of this project does not preclude future consideration, planning, or reintroduction of the project should financial conditions or community priorities change.

**SECTION 4.** The Town Manager and Mayor are authorized to update and execute all relevant planning documents, budgets, and capital improvement schedules to reflect the discontinuance of the project including appropriate notification of agencies regarding the decision of the Board of Commissioners to discontinue the project.

**SECTION 5.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
