**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF
SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, AUTHORIZING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE
MAURY COUNTY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PARTNERSHIP FOR FISCAL
YEAR 2026–2027**

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill recognizes the importance of economic development activities that promote business growth, job creation, investment, and economic prosperity within the region; and

WHEREAS, the Maury County Economic Development Partnership provides economic development services that benefit the citizens, businesses, and communities of Maury County, including the City of Spring Hill; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen has determined that appropriating funds to support the Maury County Economic Development Partnership serves a public purpose and is in the best interest of the City of Spring Hill; and

WHEREAS, funds for this appropriation have been included in the Fiscal Year 2026–2027 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, hereby approves an appropriation in the amount of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) to the Maury County Economic Development Partnership for Fiscal Year 2026–2027.
