

RESOLUTION 26-204

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE LEGACY POINT SEWER LINE TIE-IN TO AN
EXISTING MANHOLE ACROSS FROM KEDRON ROAD AND APPROVING THE
ASSOCIATED ROAD CLOSURE AND DETOUR PLAN**

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen recognize the need to connect the sewer line serving Legacy Point to the existing sewer system; and

WHEREAS, the Board and Mayor and Alderman of the City of Spring Hill approve the proposed sewer line tie-in to the existing manhole across from Kedron Road; and

WHEREAS, Legacy Point is authorized to install lane closure, detour, and traffic control devices between 4:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on Monday, July 6, 2026; and

WHEREAS, all remaining lane closure, detour, and traffic control devices within the Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) right-of-way shall be installed beginning at 6:00 a.m. on July 6, 2026; and

WHEREAS, construction operations may commence at 6:00 a.m. on July 6, 2026, and continue through July 12, 2026, with the contractor working continuous 12-hour shifts, day and night, throughout this period to expedite completion of the project; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill hereby approves the sewer line tie-in to the existing manhole located across from Kedron Road, together with the associated road closure and detour plan, for the duration of the construction project.
