

**RESOLUTION 26-202**

**TO AMEND RESOLUTION 26-95 TO APPROVE A FUNDING REQUEST FOR  
LAND ACQUISITION PURCHASE FOR THE KEDRON ROAD/OLD KEDRON  
ROAD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen have included the Kedron Road/Old Kedron Road intersection improvement project in the 10-year Capital Improvement Project Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to complete the project, Resolution 26-95 was approved for the City acquire land from a private owner in the amount of \$175,000.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the amount approved by Resolution 26-95 did not include closing costs for the transaction in the amount of \$2,610.75; and

**WHEREAS**, staff recommends amending the approved total to \$177,610.75 to include the cost of the acquisition and the closing costs due.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City of Spring Hill, Board of Mayor and Aldermen approves to amend Resolution 26-95 to include the closings costs associated with a land acquisition purchase for the Kedron Road/Old Kedron Road intersection improvement project for a total amount of \$177,610.75.
