**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF SUV REPLACEMENT FOR
FIRE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Fire Department operates a career fire department that responds to all hazards within the city; and

WHEREAS; the Fire Department has identified the need to replace (1) 2013 support vehicle SUV with a new SUV that is capable of multiple tasks including incident command, pulling fire department special operations trailers, and carrying supplies and equipment; and

WHEREAS; the department built specifications for the vehicle replacement and obtained the estimated amount which was included and approved in the FY27 Budget; and

WHEREAS, a replacement SUV is available on State of Tennessee Purchasing Contract with Wilson County Motors; and

WHEREAS, once the replacement SUV is placed fully into service, the retired vehicle will be disposed of on GovDeals.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen to approve the purchase of a 2026 Chevrolet Tahoe SUV from Wilson County Motors under State of Tennessee Vehicle Contract SWC209 for a price of \$54,320.20 and to dispose of the department's 2013 Dodge Durango.
