Agenda Items

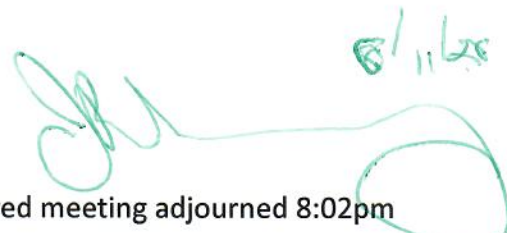
- Motion to add Anise Blackman to the agenda between items 3 and 4 – Matt 1st Molly 2nd all approve
- 1) Motion to approve last meetings minutes – Brent 1st Maryann 2nd all approve
 - 2) Rudra Tank Eagle Scout project – Looking at putting up message boards in Fisher park. To be completed between June 22nd and June 26th. Need to rethink the best location for the boards. Motion to funding for 2 boards up to but not exceeding \$1500 – Brent 1st, Maryann 2nd all approve
 - 3) Luke O’Neal Eagle Scout Project – Looking to create a children’s nature walk in Fisher park on the west side. Would be source from local materials and natural materials. Upkeep and maintenance would be very minimal. Just looking for an OK to start the project. Would be completed in August. Motion to approve nature walk/area in Fisher Park – 1st Brent, 2nd Matt all approve
 - 4) Anise Blackman Eagle Scout project – Looking to build and install insect hotels, about 8. These are to help give a home to pollinator insects and to use it for educational purposes. No funding requested. Would look to place a few in Fisher park and in the community garden to help with pollination. Need to finalize locations. Motion to approve the insect hotels and finalize locations – Brent 1st, Molly 2nd all approve
 - 5) BOMA update – Budget is the biggest issue as well as infrastructure issues. The E-Bikes across the town are becoming an issue and enforcement is going to start being amped up.
 - 6) Harvey Park Playground Kayce Williams – Ground material is going to turf. Looks to be the lowest maintenance and coolest material for the playground. Looking to change some colors and to add monkey bars.
 - 7) Master Plan RFQ Discussion – HDLA is in the lead. Looking to interview the top 3 at the next meeting. Motion to interview the to 3 at the June 11th meeting to provide recommendations to BOMA – Brent 1st, Maryann 2nd all approve
 - 8) Director update – Harvy park greenway and Jenkins connector are still in the works. Hill Fest is the next big event and the budget has been submitted.
