

RESOLUTION 26-222

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE INSTALLATION SERVICES FOR THE REPLACEMENT FRP WEIRS AND SCUM BAFFLES FOR CLARIFIER NO. 2 AT THE WATER RECLAMATION FACILITY

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill owns and operates the Water Reclamation Facility, including Secondary Clarifier No. 2, which is critical infrastructure for the proper treatment of wastewater; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen has previously authorized the purchase of replacement fiberglass reinforced plastic (FRP) weirs and scum baffles for Secondary Clarifier No. 2 to restore hydraulic performance, improve treatment efficiency, and maintain regulatory compliance; and

WHEREAS, installation of the replacement FRP weirs and scum baffles requires specialized technical expertise, including field measurements, removal of the existing anchoring system, site preparation, installation, alignment, and adjustment in accordance with the manufacturer's specifications; and

WHEREAS, BAR Environmental Supply, Inc. is the sole authorized distributor and service provider for Enduro Composites clarifier equipment throughout Middle and East Tennessee and is the authorized vendor qualified to perform the installation of these proprietary components while maintaining manufacturer requirements and product performance; and

WHEREAS, the Water Reclamation Division has budgeted funds in the FY 2026/2027 Budget for the installation services under Account No. 410-52210-52621 – Repairs and Maintenance Machinery and Equipment, in the amount of \$46,375.00; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends authorizing the installation services with BAR Environmental Supply, Inc. for the installation of the replacement FRP weirs and scum baffles for Secondary Clarifier No. 2 at the Water Reclamation Facility; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Alderman authorizes the installation services of FRP Weirs and Scum Baffles for Clarifier No. 2 from Bar Environmental Supply, Inc.
