

RESOLUTION NO. 26-221

A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE CITY OF SPRING HILL ADDITIONAL DESIGN REQUIREMENTS FOR DECENTRALIZED WASTEWATER SYSTEMS

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill has coordinated with the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) to develop Standard Technical Specifications for decentralized wastewater treatment systems utilizing BioClere treatment technology; and

WHEREAS, TDEC has approved the City's BioClere Standard Technical Specifications and requires the accompanying Additional Design Requirements for Decentralized Wastewater Systems to be formally adopted by the City for implementation; and

WHEREAS, the Additional Design Requirements establish engineering standards governing the planning, design, permitting, construction, operation, and maintenance of decentralized wastewater systems within the City's jurisdiction and are intended to be used in conjunction with the approved BioClere specifications; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, that the City of Spring Hill Additional Design Requirements for Decentralized Wastewater Systems, attached hereto, are hereby approved and adopted as the City's official engineering design requirements for decentralized wastewater systems and shall be used in conjunction with the TDEC-approved BioClere Standard Technical Specifications.
