SUBJECT: Resolution 26-193, Approval of Task Order No. 2 with J.R. Wauford & Company (Ardurra) for Engineering Design of the Columbia Interconnect Force Main Project

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends approval of Resolution 26-193, Task Order No. 2 with J.R. Wauford & Company, Consulting Engineers, Inc. (Ardurra) for engineering services associated with the design of the Columbia Interconnect Force Main Project in the amount of \$530,000.00.

BACKGROUND: The City is pursuing a wastewater interconnect with the City of Columbia as part of its efforts to address wastewater capacity limitations and comply with Consent Order No. WPC25-0093. Task Order No. 2 provides for engineering services necessary to evaluate improvements to the main sewage pumping station at the Spring Hill Wastewater Treatment Plant and prepare plans, specifications, permits and contract documents for approximately 23,600 linear feet of 12-inch force main and associated pumping facilities that will convey up to 1.5 MGD of wastewater to the City of Columbia system.

FINANCIAL IMPACT: The total cost of the task order is \$530,000 and funding will be provided through budgeted Wastewater funds in account 410-52427-59123.
