

RESOLUTION 26-227

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE LETTER OF INTENT

WHEREAS, it is proposed that Maury County Tennessee (the “County”), transfer ownership of Jerry Erwin Park (the “Park”) to the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee (the “City”); and

WHEREAS, the Park is located within the city limits of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Park is utilized primarily by City residents; and

WHEREAS, the attached nonbinding Letter of Intent memorializes proposed terms whereby the County would convey the Park to the City; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of both the County and the City to explore the transfer of the Park from the County to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Letter of Intent and engage in discussions with the County regarding definitive terms for the contemplated transfer.
