

RESOLUTION 26-201

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN THE REVISION OF THE ARP NON-COLLABORATIVE STATE WATER INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT (SWIG) RELATED TO THE CENTRIFUGE DEWATERING SYSTEM PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill previously was awarded federal ARP funds from Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) for the Centrifuge Dewatering System Project; and

WHEREAS, the project originally provided funding for engineering design services, bidding services, construction, and procurement of centrifuge dewatering equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City previously authorized the revision of the project through Resolution 26-160 by reducing the budget and scope; and

WHEREAS, TDEC agrees with the City to reduce the project scope and budget to align with grant contract deadline; and

WHEREAS, due to the inability to utilize the grant funds for the originally awarded project purposes by the grant deadline, a total grant amount of Seven Hundred Fifteen Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty Dollars and Sixty-Three Cents (\$715,760.63) will be returned; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to sign and complete all necessary documentation associated with the revised Centrifuge Project scope and budget.
