SUBJECT: Resolution 26213 | A RESOLUTION TO CLOSE FISCHER PARK FOR THE ANNUAL CAMPING IN THE PARK EVENT

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

To approve the temporary closure of Fischer Park for the 2025 Campin' In The Park event from dawn on September 19th through 9:00 am on September 20th.

BACKGROUND:

We have received our approved special event permit for our 5th annual camping event in Fischer Park on September 19th – 20th. Temporarily closing the park for this event is still the safest course of action for the participants as people will be staying overnight. The park would be closed all day on Saturday the 19th and would reopen on Sunday the 20th at 9:00 am. We will put signage up in the park to notify the public. Fire, PD, and EM will have a strong presence throughout daytime portions of the event and PD will stay with us overnight.
