

RESOLUTION 26-226

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR THE CONTINUED EVALUATION AND THOUGHTFUL ENHANCEMENT OF TENNESSEE'S ELECTRIC BICYCLE LAWS.

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen recognizes the increasing popularity and use of electric bicycles throughout the State of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes the importance of protecting public safety while preserving Tennessee's tradition of personal responsibility and limited government regulation; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee has recently updated its electric bicycle statutes, providing an opportunity to evaluate the effectiveness of those changes as implementation continues; and

WHEREAS, the Board believes future legislative changes should be guided by operational experience, public safety data, and sound public policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Mayor and Aldermen expresses its support for the continued evaluation and thoughtful enhancement of Tennessee's electric bicycle laws; respectfully encourages Governor Bill Lee and the Tennessee General Assembly to review the effectiveness of Tennessee's current statutory framework; encourages consideration of targeted legislative enhancements including improved enforcement tools, clarification regarding modified electric bicycles, expanded public education, and continued collection of crash and enforcement data; and directs the Mayor to transmit a certified copy of this Resolution to the Governor and the City's legislative delegation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
