**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF COMMAND VEHICLE FOR
FIRE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Fire Department operates a career fire department that responds to all hazards within the city; and

WHEREAS; the Fire Department has identified the need to purchase a new incident command vehicle for use by the on-duty Battalion Chief; and

WHEREAS; the vehicle is the center point of command, control, and resource coordination on emergency scenes; and

WHEREAS; the department built specifications for the vehicle replacement and obtained the quoted amount in the FY27 Budget; and

WHEREAS, the replacement vehicle, as specified, is available on the HGAC group purchasing platform as a turn-key product that will expedite the vehicle build at competitive pricing; and

WHEREAS, the current vehicle will be re-assigned within the department for use by the new Deputy Chief position, also approved in FY27.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen to approve the purchase of a new Chevrolet 2500HD Incident Command Vehicle by Fastlane Emergency Vehicles in Purcellville, VA using HGAC Contract #11117 for the price of \$137,438.00.
