Whereas, we <u>Rogers Group, Inc.</u> entered into a contract with the TOWN OF THOMPSON'S STATION, on <u>January 25</u>, 2021 for the construction by said Contractor of the above designated contract; and Whereas, certain items of construction encountered are not covered by the original contract, we desire to submit the following additional items of construction to be performed by the Contractor and paid by the Town at the prices scheduled therefore below:

Reason for Change Order:

- 1) The Town indicated they would like additional traffic control measures installed at the closure at Clayton Arnold and Critz Lane. The contractor submitted pricing for water filled portable barrier rail and concrete portable barrier rail. Based on the pricing the water filled barriers were cheaper and would serve the intended purpose of traffic closure.
- 2) Per Change Order No.1, there were 2 changeable message units placed for the project. The contractor priced the units for a duration of 4 months which ended in April 2022. The contractor was asked to keep the message units on-site for the duration of the project which extends the use of the message units until April 2023.
- 3) The original plans indicated Structure Number 16 being installed near the edge of pavement. There was concern of the drop-off caused by the structure being installed near the edge of pavement. RaganSmith revised the drawings to move the headwall away from the edge of pavement and associated grading and pipe extension caused by the revision. Adding line item for remove and reset headwall that was not an existing item in the contract. All other items affected by the work are existing line items and will be captured in the field.

Good afternoon,

I apologize for not getting back sooner when Brandon brought this up to me last week.

The changeable message boards were added as part of Change Order No. 1 and to maintain the cost of that change order to be under the pre-approved amount by BOMA, the message boards were priced using a duration of 4 months. Since the change order was initiated in January the message boards should have been removed from the project at the end of April. I spoke with the contractor at the end of last week and they were aware they were to be removed but left them in-place for this additional time since there was some delays on the project. I have asked them for pricing for maintaining the message boards on the project for the remainder of the project or price them on a monthly price.

If the Town wishes to continue to have the message boards please let me know which direction they would like, to either have them for the duration of the project of for a shorter time period and I will get the contractor to price them accordingly. We will add them to Change Order No. 2 that will include the headwall relocation, additional barrier rails and the message boards.
